Job Description

A Spanish teacher's responsibilities teaching Grades 4-8 should focus on the FIVE C's of learning a language; communication, culture, connections, comparisons and communities. The curriculum is developed by the teacher under the guidance of the Massachusetts frameworks, but not limited to or restricted to only this plan. Preparing the whole child to become efficient in reading, writing and speaking is done through tailored instruction and integrated cultural lessons. Lesson plans should be flexible and differentiated to fit individual needs within the different age groups. Varied assessments are evident through hands-on activities such as singing, crafts and/or skits, and also in traditional methods such as tests and projects as students move up into middle school. Multi-tasking is extremely important in order to implement curriculum, along with flexibility, fluency in Spanish and a love of teaching children of all ages. Creativity, compassion and thinking outside the box are essential in order to carry out the curriculum while being part of both elementary and middle school teams.
