As a Catholic School in Boston's historical North End with small class sizes, we seek to nurture and support each of our youngest learners as they grow. Hours are Monday through Friday, 7:30 am to 3 pm. A year's teaching experience in a classroom setting or youth programs is preferred. EEC certificate is preferred but not required. Candidates must be capable to assist students to different locations with students' safety in mind at all times.

Candidates must be pragmatic, flexible, and eager to make a positive difference in our school community. As a Catholic school, we seek to employ candidates who share their own Faith experiences and who are fully supportive of the Church's teachings.

Teacher's aides are expected to assist throughout the day with all aspects of the classroom including supervising children during recess, lunch, arrival, and dismissal.
